

Russian student enrollment in U.S. universities in 2007-2008*

- In the academic year 2007-2008, 4,906 students from Russia studied in the United States. That is a 3.3 percent increase from the previous year.
- Russian student enrollment at U.S. universities:
 - 39.7% studied at the undergraduate level
 - 45.6% studied at the graduate level
 - 8.1% were engaged in their post-graduate Optional Practical Training.
 - 6.7% were engaged in studies other than undergraduate or graduate degree matriculation programs.
